## COVENANTS REVISION PASSES

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**A special purpose** association meeting was held on June 4<sup>th</sup> to vote on the final draft of the covenants revision. After some final discussion about how the changes would functionally alter the conduct and conditions within the Association, the votes were tallied, including both mail-in ballots and votes cast in person, with the following results:

In favor:	35
Opposed:	1
Abstaining:	21

A 60% majority is necessary in order to pass any changes to the Crumbacher Estates Restrictive Covenants. There are a total of 57 lots within the Association, requiring a minimum of 35 votes to meet the 60% stipulation. All votes submitted were in written form, and will be maintained with the Association records. The ballots may be reviewed upon written request to the Board.

With the passage of these covenants, a number of issues are resolved or set in place. The series of amendments that were enacted in years past, with some question as to their legality, are now legitimately incorporated into the main body of the covenants. The Board now has the responsibility to set policies governing how they will enforce the various covenants in a fair, equitable, and consistent manner. Finally, several covenants have been amended, giving members greater latitude in the maintenance of their properties.

The next step in the process will be to submit a final copy of the covenants to the county auditor's office for recording. When this has been completed, each member will be given a copy of the new document. We will also notify local realtors that the new covenants are available for download on the association website.

## IMPROVED WEBSITE ACCESS

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**Since the Crumbacher** Estates website was first put online, some members have experienced problems in accessing the site. After a good deal of communication with the host and the internet provider, Ken Radford was finally able to get the problem corrected.

The blockage seemed to occur when access to the website was attempted from certain local area internet

pathways. NCIData.com located and corrected the issue, and it seems to have fixed the problem.

## VEHICLE SPEED
