ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of CRUMBACHER ESTATES OWNERS ASSOCIATION

We, the undersigned persons, acting as the incorporators of an association under the provisions of the Washington Non-Profit Corporation Act (Revised Code of Washington 24.06), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such association:

ARTICLE I

The name of the association shall be "Crumbacher Estates
Owners Association."

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the association shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of this association is to form a non-profit owners association for the mutual benefit of the present and future owners of property lying within Crumbacher Estates, a recorded plat, according to the files and records of the Auditor of Okanogan County, Washington. Further, the association shall develope and distribute domestic water and irrigation water; and will maintain the private road system within said plat, as well as enforce restrictive covenants accompanying and pertaining to said plat as filed with the Okanogan County Auditor; pay all real estate taxes levied against the association; and assess property owners proportionately to defray cost of operation, all according to By-Laws to be hereinafter approved.

Specifically, with regard to domestic and irrigation water, the purposes of this association are to acquire, construct, purchase, rent, own, maintain, and operate a domestic water service now existing and to be constructed or used in the future, and to provide domestic and irrigation water service as required by the members of the association; to sink wells and shafts, and to make, build and construct, lay down and maintain, reservoirs, cisterns, culverts, filter-beds, mains and other pipes and appliances, and to execute and do all other works and things necessary or convenient for obtaining, storing, selling, delivering, measuring, and distributing water; and for such purposes to buy, sell and transfer real and personal property, to borrow money, and do all things necessary, convenient and proper in the conduct of the business of said association.

ARTICLE IV

No water of this association shall be used on any other land than that hereinafter described, to-wit:

Crumbacher Estates, a recorded plat, according to the files and records of the Auditor of Okanogan County, Washington, recorded May 15, 1975, in Book H of Plats, Section 2, page 28, under Auditors File No. 614576.

unless so allowed by the by-laws of this association, but such water shall be available to any owner of any lot in said sub-division upon such owner's compliance with the by-laws of this association with regard to the qualifications for member-ship herein, as well as in other particulars. Further, this association shall not use such water, or the association's property, as a public utility company, but solely for use and benefit of its members.

ARTICLE V

There shall be no capital stock in this association, but membership therein shall be evidenced by a membership certificate, according to the by-laws.

ARTICLE VI

The address of the initial registered office of the association shall be c/o John Oakes, Pine Creek Star Route, Tonasket, Washington 98855, and the name of the initial registered agent of the association at such address shall be John Oakes.

ARTICLE VII

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of this association shall be three (3) directors, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors of the association are as follows:
